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### Grand Day Out V Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2019

Dear Parents,

We have organized the 'Grand Day Out V' for all classes from years 1-6. We intend to take the Key Stage 2 children on a fell walk from Braithwaite village up Stile End and back down Barrow and we intend to take the Key stage 1 (Year 1 and 2) on a forest walk through Whinlatter forest. Reception intend to take the children to Harris Park for the morning but they will be back in school in time for school lunches.

The buses for Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) will be leaving school from 9:30am onwards and will return in time for the end of the school day. The buses for Key Stage 1 (Year 1 & 2) will be leaving school from 10am onwards and will also return in time for the end of the school day.

Your child will need to bring a rucksack with their own packed lunch and a drink as Lunchshop will not be available unless your child is in receipt of a Universal Infant Free school meal (Year 1 & 2) or free school meals. Those eligible will be able to log onto Lunchshop and place an order for this trip. A packed lunch will be delivered to school prior to setting off on the day.

Pupils should wear suitable clothing and footwear (walking boots) for being outside for the day. This should include a waterproof coat (and trousers if possible) in case of rain. They will also need a hat, gloves and a scarf just in case it is a cold but sunny and fresh October day! They will also need to bring a plastic bag (or similar) to sit on when having their lunch.

There is a voluntary contribution of £3.20 for this trip to cover the cost of the transport. Please make payment via School Money by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> October as school reserves the right to cancel the trip should we not receive sufficient voluntary contributions.
