

English Writing Task – Mouse Bird Snake Wolf


In this session, you are going to explore how characters in a story have viewpoint and voice. You will step into Ben's shoes and think about how he thinks and feels at an important turning point in this story.




"Of course not!"

marvellous thing."


And they stood still and stared up into the clouds and they yelled, "Isn't it? Isn't a wolf a wonderful, beautiful, marvellous thing?"







And the one god who heard them looked down and smiled, and shrugged, and muttered, "Yes, children. I suppose it is." And fell fast asleep.



















Imagine you are Ben, what are you thinking and feeling at this point in the story?
