Year 5 – Cinema, Arts at Cockermouth School, Celebrating Wordsworth – 18th – 22nd Nov. 2019

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have a very busy week coming up with lots of exciting events!

First of all, we have been offered the opportunity to visit Keswick Alhambra cinema on Monday 18th November to watch the film 'The Kid Who Would Be King'. This film will give the children an understanding of the legend of King Arthur which will be very useful when we come to learn about the stories later in the year. There are also themes of friendship, perseverance and kindness throughout the film which link to PSHE topics we have covered this term.

The film itself is free of charge, however we are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £4 per child**, payable via SchoolMoney, to fund our transport to and from Keswick.

The film will be shown during the morning and children will return to school in time for lunch.

On Tuesday 19th November, Cockermouth School are hosting an art session for all year 5 pupils. We will be walking to and from Cockermouth School during the school day, however, due to the timing of the session **all children will require a packed lunch on Tuesday 19th November**.

Finally, on Thursday 21st and Friday 22nd November, year 5 will be participating in the next phase of our project celebrating William Wordsworth. A poet and a sound artist will be visiting school to deliver workshops alongside representatives from CDEC global learning centre. This project is completely free for year 5 as it is being funded by the Arts Council.

We are very much looking forward to a packed week of activities and are extremely fortunate that the majority of our plans are fully funded, however we would really appreciate a few parent/carer volunteers to come with to the cinema during the morning of Monday 18th November and to Cockermouth School from 10:15am until 1:00pm on Tuesday 19th Nov., if you are able to join us, please get in touch via Dojo.
