Dear Parents/Carers

Residential School Journey In Year 6 (for children currently in Y5)

As your child will be moving into Year 6, we would like inform you about our annual **School Journey**. This is a really exciting opportunity for children to spend a couple of days away at a fully registered activity centre deep in the Surrey countryside. This has been an extremely popular trip in the past and we have a limited number of places. The children develop in confidence and independence over the stay and always come back exhausted, but full of stories and enthusiasm about the time they have had.

The dates we are provisionally looking at for School Journey 2026 (Wednesday 7th October – Friday 9th October) The estimated cost of the trip will be between £190.00 and £200.00, which includes:

- Transport both to and from the venue (by coach), leaving from and returning to school
- Full bed and board (Wed - Fri)
- Breakfast which usually includes: a cooked option as well as cereals and porridge, toast and butter, jam or marmalade. Lunches include: 2 or 3 cooked options including halal, fruit, yoghurt, juice. Dinner includes: 2 or 3 cooked options including halal, pudding, fruit. The centre will also cater for any specific dietary requirements and provide meals accordingly.
- Several action packed activities which are directed and supervised by **fully trained staff**.

Many of the activities that the children have the opportunity to participate in will allow them to face their fears and work as a team they **may** include:

- Abseiling
- Climbing Wall
- Jacob's Ladder
- Nightline
- Zip wire
- Archery
- Campfire
- Fencing



- 3G Swing
- Leap of Faith
- Mini-Olympics
- Orienteering
- Scrapheap Challenge
- Problem Solving
- Jungle Vines

Whilst the cost of this trip may seem expensive, **if there is enough interest from parents and we decide to go ahead with the trip**, we will be able to set up payment plans so that families can pay in instalments, rather than having to find the whole amount in one go.
