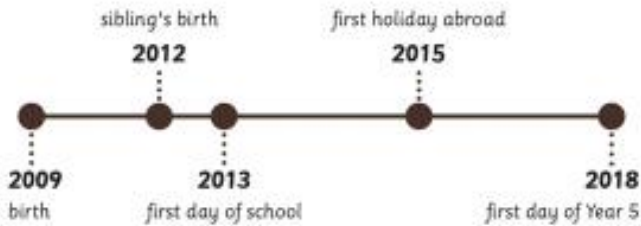




## Memories

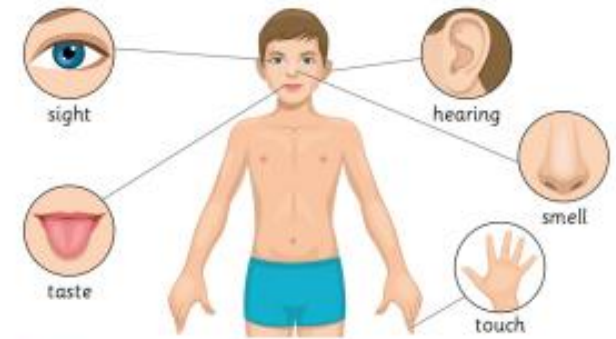

### Glossary

<b>baby</b>	A very young child.
<b>birthday</b>	The day when a person was born that is celebrated every year.
<b>human</b>	A man, woman or child.
<b>memory</b>	Something remembered from the past.
<b>new</b>	Something that was made or came recently.
<b>old</b>	Something that has lived or been made for a long time.
<b>parent</b>	A person's mum or dad.
<b>toddler</b>	A young child who is just starting to walk.

Key Facts	
<b>How long have toys existed?</b>	Toys have existed for thousands of years. They were made out of the materials that were available at the time. Even stones and string have been made into toys.
<b>What were toys made of during the <b>Victorian</b> age?</b>	Toys were mainly made of wood, paper and metal during the <b>Victorian</b> age.
<b>What toys did <b>Victorian</b> children play with?</b>	Rich <b>Victorian</b> children played with toys such as clockwork trains, rocking horses, tea sets and dolls. Poorer children played with homemade toys such as peg dolls, wooden boats and rags stuffed with sawdust to make balls or toy animals.
<b>What are modern toys made of?</b>	Modern toys are mainly made of plastic. This is because it is usually safer and easier to make things with.
<b>How are modern toys different?</b>	Many modern toys use electricity to work. Computers and consoles were invented in the <b>20<sup>th</sup> century</b> .
