This workgroup looks at the barriers in topics that pupils find difficult and addresses how we can unpick these for GCSE. Also unpicking further down the year groups and addressing issues at KS3 to prevent the barriers before they get to GCSE.

2. Secondary Teaching for Mastery – Only one place remaining so be very fast

The Work Groups provide an opportunity for schools to engage in high-quality, sustained, collaborative professional development and participate in an important national project. The aim of these groups is to support participating teachers in developing teaching for mastery in their own classroom and across their department and to support the development of collaborative ways of working within the department.

We ideally need to get this final place filled very quickly as we need to get the Work Group up and running (all be it remotely) as soon as possible. This is a fully funded programme and participating schools benefit from bespoke support from one of our Secondary Mathematics Mastery Specialists, as well as the chance to collaborate with other participating schools and teachers. There is also a participation grant of £2,000 to go towards the costs of releasing teachers.

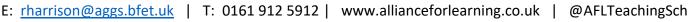
