



Welcome to Year 3! Autumn Term



Daily reminders:

Each day, children should bring their Reading Record into school, along with their library book, and take it home at home time.

Spellings:

The Year 3 Spellings list will be going home on Monday 11th September.

Spellings will also be set on Spelling Shed from Week 3 (W/C 18.09.23).

Spellings will be tested every **Monday**.

In addition, your child is required to learn the Year 3/4 common exception words. All spellings and Y3/4 common exception words can be found on the school website.

Reading

We would like children in Year 3 to be reading their library book four or more times a week and would recommend reading for 15 minutes each time. Children or adults can record reading by jotting down any notes in their Reading Record.

Maths

We will be setting **weekly online Maths homework** using a platform called Atom. This will commence in Week 3 (W/C 18.09.23). Children are also encouraged to practise their times tables regularly and can use TT Rockstars for this.

PE:

PE kits are to be worn on **Mondays and Tuesdays** during this half term.

Children are to come into school in their school-expected PE kit on these days.

Make up and Jewellery

A polite reminder that nail varnish, make-up and all jewellery (other than a single pair of studs) are not permitted to be worn in school by pupils.

Homework projects

Children are asked to complete a project related to their current learning each half term. Additional information about this is on a separate letter.
