Please encourage your child to explore the world of books by completing our reading challenge. The purpose of this challenge is to promote pleasure in reading. We would expect children to earn one of the awards each term, completing the whole challenge in July. **Take your time and enjoy the books! You have until July 2021 to complete the challenge!**



How to complete the challenge

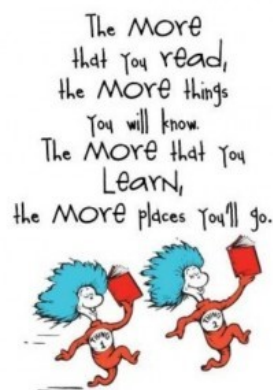
- Choose a book to read from the challenge—either from home, the school library or local library (see below)
- Your child could read it for themselves, or you could share the book together.
- Write the date in the corresponding square and colour the square. You may have already have read some books on the challenge—why not read them again before ticking it off on the challenge? (Re-reading books increases reading fluency and improves comprehension)
- You could also write these books into your reading record.
- Bring your challenge sheet into school every time you achieve an award

3 rows	Silver bookmark
All squares	Gold pin-on badge

Children will visit our school library once a fortnight with their class to borrow a book.

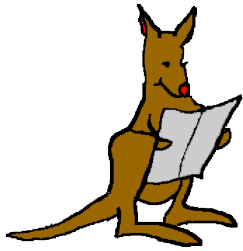
