

What 'remote learning' is provided by Boldmere Infant and Nursery School in the event of a child needing to isolate?

Circumstance	Teacher feedback for Remote Learning
My child (<i>and their siblings if they are also attending Boldmere Infant and Nursery School</i>) is absent because they are awaiting test results and our household is required to self-isolate.	Your child's teacher will have uploaded lessons for each subject, onto Google Classroom. Work can be submitted, if desired, once it has been completed, but your child's class teacher will not provide feedback as they are still working at their full capacity in school.
My child's whole bubble (Class group or Year group) is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid-19.	Your child's teacher will have uploaded lessons for each subject onto Google Classroom. Your child's teacher will request certain work to be submitted once it has been completed. The teacher will provide some feedback (as long as the teacher is well enough to do so).
We enter another 'lockdown' with total school closure.	Your child's teacher will have uploaded lessons for each subject onto Google Classroom. This work will have a due date for completion and submission. The teacher will provide some feedback (as long as the teacher is well enough to do so).

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

All information will be uploaded onto Google Classroom.

- **Mathematics:** Maths lessons from White Rose Maths Hub, following on/mirroring the maths taught in the classroom at that time. There will be one lesson uploaded each day. We use the White Rose Maths scheme in school.
 - **Mathletics:** Mathletics is a great online resource to support children with their Maths learning. They can complete activities or compete against others around the world, using a range of maths skills. All children have their individual username and password to allow access at home.
- **Phonics:** Daily phonic lessons, following on/mirroring the phonics being taught in the classroom at that time.
- **Reading:** Your child will have their reading book available in their book bag. Inside the reading diary cover, are reading prompts which will help support your child's reading skills. In addition, Oxford Reading Owl provide free access to a range of reading books matched to reading bands. Enjoy choosing books that match the reading band your child is currently working at.
Children will have a word list with a set of words for them to learn to read by sight (these words are not decodable, cannot be 'sounded' out), teachers will update this list weekly.
- **Writing:** Daily writing lessons, following on/mirroring the writing skills taught in the classroom at that time. Some lessons will be linked to The Oak Academy, where appropriate.
- **Spellings:** You will find the year groups Common Exception words to practice and learn, on your child's Google Classroom stream. There are approximately 100 spellings for both the Year 1 & 2.
- **Foundation lessons:** All Foundation subjects that are taught during the current half term, will be uploaded onto Google Classroom to ensure that children may still access a full curriculum. Some of these lessons are following on/mirroring the skills taught in the classroom at that time. They will use the same PowerPoints and resources that the children, who are in school, will be accessing. Where lessons are more discussion based, links to the National Oak Academy or BBC Bitesize (as recommended by the DFE) will be provided to support learning.

Nursery

The Nursery staff will provide a focus activity, and play based activity each day. These will be following on/mirroring the skills taught in the classroom at that time. A story, read by the Nursery teachers, will be uploaded on Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week. These stories will link to the theme for that half term.

*Please note that work will be available daily in the '**classwork**' area.

Please check the '**stream**' area for timetables and messages from your child's class teacher.

***Year group email addresses** are only to be used to support teaching and learning, for example, a query about a lesson, or clarification of an activity.
