The charity relies on volunteer parents and carers (like you) donating their time to plan, organise and run the events and fundraising activities.

Unfortunately in recent years, the number of volunteers who regularly contribute their time to organise PTA events has gradually reduced, either as their work commitments have changed or as children (and their parents) have moved on to secondary school. It is not sustainable to rely on the same small group of volunteers to organise and run all PTA events throughout the calendar year without additional support.

So, how you can help?

We're inviting you and small groups of friends to take on and share some of the tasks & responsibilities involved in a particular stall at the Summer Fair. More details are on the next page but these include the planning of the stall, working out costs involved, organising a small group of volunteers to run the stall at the event.

This is your opportunity to give something back to help YOUR PTA run a successful Summer Fair to raise money that will benefit your children.

The PTA will **provide guidance** and will assist with background admin, risk assessments, printing, money floats, card machines etc.

We want to be clear that without sufficient volunteers, the Summer Fair may not go ahead. This means a reduced amount of funds will be raised by the PTA, which ultimately means your children will not benefit as much as they could do.
