#### **Parking near to School**

Due to recent complaints from local residents could all families please remember that when dropping off and collecting children cars should always be parked respectfully, not blocking residents' driveways, or parking in their designated disabled spaces.

#### Medication required during the school day

If your child needs to take any medication during the school day this MUST be given by a parent or responsible adult to the School Office and complete a consent form for the medication to be administered by school staff.

Any prescribed medication must be in the original packaging which has a chemist label with your child's name on it.

Non-prescribed medication such as Calpol, cough medicine, Strepsils and eye drops should also be in the original container or box and can be given once a consent form has been completed.

Please do not send any medication with your child or in their bags.
