Busy Bodies Important Information

A huge thank you to all our families who already returned their February forms along with their signed consent forms in acknowledgement of our fees increase from April 2022.

February booking form- to be returned no later than Wednesday 26th January 2022, as your February booking form starts the week commencing 31st January. Fees must be paid in advance being no later than Friday 28th January. Please ensure that your child's ParentPay account is clear and up to date, in order for us to accept your required session for next month's form.

Outstanding fees

We ask that parents check their children's ParentPay account to ensure that they do not have any outstanding fees. The Busy Bodies Manager will be sending out reminders today, should you have any queries regarding your children's fees, please do not hesitate in contacting the Manager in the first instance.

After school sports clubs

After school sports clubs have commenced this week and some of our Busy Bodies children will be attending. Polite reminder to parents, please inform the Busy Bodies Manager if your child/ren will be attending these sessions and later returning to Busies.

Any children cancelling the whole afternoon session will automatically receive a full refund as we can then allocate their place to other children waiting for these days.

Children who will be returning to Busies after the sports club session, will all receive a snack and their normal session fees will still apply as we will not be able to allocate their session to any other families due to the children returning to us afterwards.

Should the sports club be cancelled for any reason, they will be able to attend Busies as their session are already reserved for them in advance.
