A message from Mr Sadler, Head of Junior School

Dear parents and carers,

As we are all aware, the Queen is celebrating her Platinum Jubilee this year and in school, there will be a number of activities that the children will be taking part in to mark the occasion. A reminder that this Thursday will be a 'red, white and blue' themed non-uniform day, and for many of our children, a school disco to follow. Additionally, after the break children will begin the final half-term of the academic year with a Jubilee themed week of music, dance and art that will see them study a particular decade of the Queen's tenure. The week will also see the children enjoy a tea party within their classes, in preparation for which children will be asked to decorate bunting as a half-term holiday project of sorts.

Year four multiplication check: As many parents will know already, our year four children will soon be tested on their recall of multiplication facts, part of the national multiplication screen that aims to assess the number of year four children who have a secure understanding of multiplication facts up to 12 x 12. For the children at Boldmere, these tests will be undertaken during the week beginning 13th June. There is a degree of flexibility in the administration of these tests meaning that children's short-term absence will not affect their opportunity to complete the tests.
