#### A message from Mr Sadler, Head of Junior School

Dear parents and carers,

First of all, a huge thank you for the completion of the parent surveys shared last week. The collection window has now closed and I am currently in the process of collating the results which will then be shared with yourselves, and factored in to any school improvement priorities for the remainder of the academic year. In other news, although we are not inundated, we continue to have Covid cases in school amongst both staff and children. As in recent weeks, these will be shared with you on a weekly basis except in the case of a significant outbreak. Where children are at home due to a positive case, our remote learning offer via google classroom will continue for children well enough to access this. Access to the remote learning will be granted as soon as possible following us being informed of the positive case. A slight change to policy regarding remote learning is that class teachers will no longer routinely make 'well-being' contact calls with children testing positive, primarily due to the shortened isolation period.
