Year One Costumes

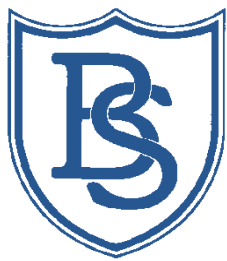
Please could all Year One children bring their costumes into school on Friday 8th December and not 15th December as stated on the letter. Sorry for any inconvenience caused.
