## Covid-19

We would like to thank all parents/carers for their cooperation during this term. We do however, need your continued support as we break up for the Christmas holidays.

If your child becomes unwell with Covid-19 symptoms after Friday 17th December, please follow Government guidelines and book a test immediately. It is vital that you make contact with school to inform us of any illness and subsequent tests results. We have a duty to ensure that we work with Track and Trace to identify all possible contacts that any children may have had at school, in the 48 hours prior to displaying symptoms. This may include contacts during the final few days at school this week. Please email the enguiry address enguiry@boldmere.bham.sch.uk to notify us of this information. Should other children/staff be identified as close contacts, they will be notified by parentmail.

If your child becomes ill with Covid-19 symptoms prior to school returning, please update school with the information and follow Government guidelines for booking a test and isolating. Please can all pupils complete a

Lateral Flow Test before they return to school on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January. (If your child has tested positive for Covid within the last 90 days then you do not need to complete an LFT test)
