SEND Sunday

A relaxed performance, put simply, is a performance that has been amended in such a way as to be sensitive to, and appreciative of, audience members who could otherwise struggle with the intensity of a regular performance. This includes, but is by no means limited to, any individuals on the autistic spectrum, those with learning disabilities and those with sensory and/or communication needs who may find sitting in a busy, enclosed space challenging.

There will be a number of alterations to the performance and overall experience, the approach and atmosphere is much more relaxed and laid back. More specifically for instance, the house lights will stay up, the sound level lowered and loud bangs and flashing light effects removed or reduced. You are of course at liberty to leave and return to the auditorium at any time should you so wish. Further to this, on the day of the relaxed performance, the environment will be tailored to a comfortable approach, including staffing, signage and various other tweaks to make sure the experience is as inclusive as possible. Bookers will receive an information pack approximately a week before the relaxed performance date as a resource to help families prepare to enjoy the experience.
