Year One Phonics Screening Meeting for Parent, Carers Date Change

There is a change of date for the phonics screening meeting originally being held on May 19th. It will now be held on Tuesday 24th March at 9.00am in the main hall. The purpose of this session is to provide parents and carers with an understanding of the Year One phonics screening check. This is a Statutory test which is used to assess phonic skills at the end of Year One.

- Please note applicants in receipt of income above £26,250 (includes the listed benefits and earnings) will not be considered.
