The letters for the Year 2 Sports Festival at the Aston Villa Inner City Academy on **Tuesday 13th May 2025** were sent home with the children last half term.


Please can all Parents/Carers complete the consent form and return it to school by Monday 10^{th} March 2025.

The class novel is Lost and Found.


ED class are recapping on place value and addition.
