

What 'home learning' can I expect from Boldmere Infant and Nursery School?

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

On Google Classroom you will find:

- **Mathematics:** Maths lessons from the White Rose Maths Hub mirroring the maths taught in the classroom at the time. There is a lesson uploaded per day; these lessons are in a sequence so should be covered in order. Each lesson has a video attached for the teaching input. Oak Academy lessons may be available to supplement White Rose Hub.
 - **Mathletics:** Mathletics is a great resource for children to continue their Maths learning. They can complete the activities or compete against others around the world using a range of their maths skills. All children should have their username and password to enable access at home.
- **Phonics:** Daily phonic lessons, mirroring the phonics being taught in the classroom at the time. Pre-recorded teaching inputs are available.
- **Reading:** Oxford Reading Owl (website) provide free access to a range of reading books. Please select and enjoy books that match the reading band indicated on the back of your child's school reading book. Please enjoy reading for pleasure by sharing stories together.

Reception and Year 1 are providing stories via video or PDF with linked activities.

You will find the year groups Common Exception words (these are not decodable, cannot be 'sounded' out) to learn to read by sight under the 'Parent Information' section.
- **Writing:** A sequence of writing lessons are provided by school or from Oak Academy. These should be covered in order. Pre-recorded teaching inputs are available when appropriate.
- **Spellings:** You will find the year groups Common Exception words to practise and learn, under the 'Parent Information' section.
- **Foundation lessons:** All Foundation subjects that are being taught during the current half term, will be uploaded onto Google Classroom so children can still access the full curriculum. The lessons that are more discussion based, will have links to the Oak Academy or BBC Bitesize (as recommended by the DFE) to support learning.

Further resources

- **Wellbeing:** A bank of ideas to support your child's wellbeing at home. These are here for you if needed. Some activities can be completed independently.
- **Play based learning activities for Reception and Nursery**– A bank of ideas to encourage learning through play to mirror the learning opportunities that are available in school through continuous provision.
- **Parent Information:** Here you will find the reading and maths parent workshop information and other useful resources e.g. sound mats, common exception word lists, number line/grid, suggested APPs list.

Nursery

On Google Classroom Nursery will provide the following each day:

- A focus activity.
- A play based or creative activity.
- A story, read by the Nursery teachers. These stories will link to the theme for that half term.

Further information

- All work for the week will be available on Google Classrooms by the end of the previous Friday. This allows time for parent/ carers to look at what is available and planning accordingly.

- Please check the '**Stream**' area on Google classroom for timetables and daily messages from your child's class teacher.
- Please upload children's work to the '**Classwork**' area. Parent friendly instructions are available on the school website under Remote Learning>Google Classroom> How to Guide.
- Teachers will provide feedback on work submitted during the hours 8 - 4.30pm. If work is submitted after this time then feedback will be given the following day. We are aware that families are home schooling at different times during the day so please don't worry if you have to submit work in the evening.
- Teachers and support staff will make regular wellbeing calls.
- If you need support with teaching and learning at home, for example, a query about a lesson or clarification of an activity please make contact via the year group email addresses.
