Heating Failure/ Severe Weather and School Closure



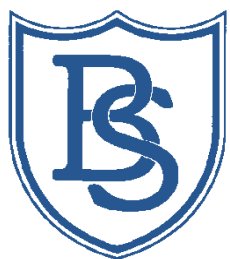
