Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome Back

Welcome back everyone! It was lovely to see lots of smiling faces this morning, and everyone very eager to share news about their Christmas holidays!

This term is a very short one in comparison to the Autumn term, so we are straight into teaching and learning from today - with the exception of a little Christmas show and tell! Our school improvement plan has been amended slightly following Ofsted in November, but monitoring activities continue as planned. We also look forward to welcoming the Governors into school in February to observe writing provision throughout school.

The temperature has certainly dropped a degree or two this week, so a quick reminder to ensure that children come prepared for playtimes outside - coats, gloves, scarves and hats are a must (all named please). Should we have challenging weather then the decision to close a school lies with the Executive Headteacher (Mr. Glasgow) and Head of School (Mrs. Kenny), in consultation with the Chair of the Governing Board. This arrangement enables decisions to be taken quickly, in the light of local circumstances and or factors unique to the school, such as local transport or site related issues. On taking the decision to close the School due to severe weather, Mr. Glasgow/Mrs. Kenny will inform BCC. An immediate update for parents/carers will be made on the school's website with notification of the closure as well as using Parentmail messaging and social media to keep parents informed.

In extreme circumstances such as very heavy snowfall, the Director, Children and Families, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Families, may decide to close all schools and centres that are maintained by BCC. The timing of the decision will be informed by an assessment of the conditions and forecast. It will also seek to prevent people making unnecessary journeys.

Headteachers will be notified of the decision via their school email. It will also be announced on the BCC website and through social media channels.

This half term we will be facilitating parents' evening on **6th and 7th February**, further details regarding the online booking system will follow in subsequent newsletters.

MMR information has been circulated via parentmail earlier today but please take time to read the current updates from NHS, including isolation periods for unvaccinated children/adults should they come into contact with a confirmed Measles case.

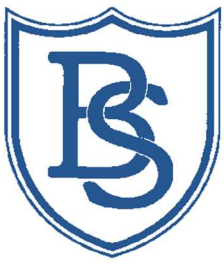
Many of our children took part in the Summer reading challenge last year which was organised by The Reading Agency through local libraries. This has been followed up by a winter reading challenge.
