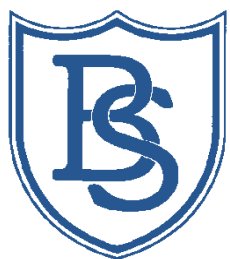
Nursery Open Day for September 2018 Intake
