Covid-19 Update

A parentmail was sent yesterday detailing the new cases that we have had reported to school since the weekend. We are fortunate that at the current time, we have just one member of staff and 11 children that are isolating with a positive covid-19 test result. A reminder that if your child has a main symptom of Covid and has a negative Lateral Flow Test you must book a PCR test. The updated Government guidance states that the period of isolation may potentially be reduced if Lateral tests on days 5 and 6 are negative. This certainly helps to reduce the impact on children's education, and we are encouraged by this guidance. These early release tests however must be registered on the NHS website, and school must be informed with the negative results via email notifications, prior to children returning to school. Thank you for your support whilst we continue to manage Covid absences at school. Please contact the office should you require any clarification around your child's absence or period of isolation.
