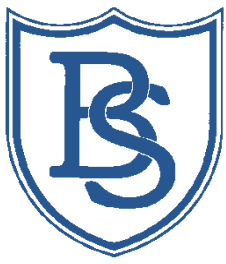

Celebrating Attendance

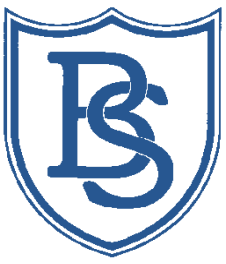
Congratulations to class for Owl class achieving 99.63% attendance last week. Well done!
