Online access for parents will be closing on Saturday 22nd July 2017.

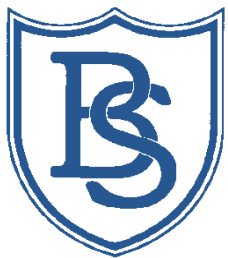
Year Two Leavers' Party
