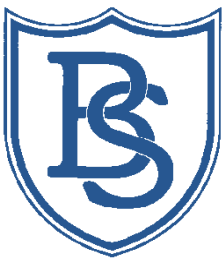

Sponsored Football Themed Camp-Out For Cure Leukaemia

Staff and children at Boldmere Infant school are joining together with St. Nicholas Catholic Primary School to support the Cure Leukaemia Foundation and raise money for vital research into childhood cancer. Two years ago, a member of our Boldmere staff and their little boy, who attends St. Nicholas Catholic Primary school, went through a diagnosis of Blood Cancer and were supported by the Cure Leukaemia Foundation. We decided that raising money for Cure Leukaemia was a way we as a community could help. Our fund raising Camp outs have been so successful for the last two years that we have decided to do it again! Last year we raised an amazing £6000! Cure Leukaemia Foundation provide fundamental research into blood cancer trials and they support not only the Haematology departments in the Midlands, but also provide support to 12 other clinics UK wide. We are holding a "Camping for a Cure-Football style" sponsored event on **Saturday 24th June 2023**, and would like children at school to participate too! Staff will be camping out for the evening and we are asking children to set up a camp too. This could be in their garden, in their bedroom or anywhere in their house! We are happy to see homemade tents in the living room, under sheets and blankets, or proper tents in the garden. We will be sending home some amazing camping activities (football themed!) for everyone, as well as a goodie bag for the camp-fire! These resources are being provided by staff and school, at no cost to children and families! Further details will be sent home after half term, but make sure you save the date!

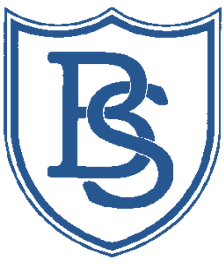
