- 1- Check -always check with the owner to make sure it's ok to greet their dog;
- 2- Call -Call the dog to you by patting your legs and saying a friendly "hello";
- 3- Count -If the dog chooses to come over, stroke them on the shoulder nearest to you up to 3 times, then stop and let them get on with their day.

The children listened with great enthusiasm to the assembly and Elaine sent the following message;

14<sup>th</sup> June for final donations.




#### Red Point climbing wall


