Statutory Phonic Screening Year 1 children spent last week completing **statutory** phonic screening checks. These tests assess children's phonic knowledge and are administered by class teachers. Children all performed brilliantly and did their best during the assessments where they read "real" and "alien" words using their phonic knowledge. Outcomes of each assessment is shared with the Local authority and results for individual children will be sent home with end of term reports at the beginning of July. If any child does not achieve the required pass mark, they will have another opportunity in Year 2 to re-take the test.

Attendance - updated processes

Our amended Attendance Processes have been circulated via Parent Mail, including request for absence forms. Please can we remind all parents/carers that you need to call (01214642338) or email

enquiry-inf@boldmere.bham.sch.uk before 9am in the morning if your child is going to be absent from school (illness or Religious Observance) or if they are going to be late for any reason.

Absences

An important reminder about absence requests and penalty notices for unauthorised absences. The Education Legal Intervention Team have notified school that they have now begun to issue penalty notices (fines) for unauthorised absences. Please note that fines are issued to **BOTH PARENTS** and **BOTH PARENTS** must pay the penalties.

Failure to pay the penalty notice, will result in the matter proceeding to court and could potentially lead to a criminal record.

Medical Appointments

A reminder that if your child will be absent from school, arrives late or has to leave early due to a medical appointment we do need to see some evidence in the school office.

We will need to keep a copy of this to support your child's medical attendance mark on the registers.

Please be reminded, bookings for July will need to be completed by next week Friday 27th June. We require monthly bookings where possible in order for us to have complete registers and cater for staff to children ratios.

We encourage you to only book sessions you require as refunds will not be given unless it falls in line with our charging policy. We have given a month's grace to allow our families to adjust to using the Arbor app, and have made cancellations where necessary to support those who needed it.

Parents can call to add ad hoc sessions where required or add these to Arbor up to 12 hours before the start of the session. Please note that you cannot cancel sessions yourselves this needs to be done by the Busy Bodies Manager.

We appreciate your patience and support as we transition from ParentPay to Arbor, and kindly ask that should you have any difficulties or recommendations, please send us an email and we will get back to you.

Learning this week:

Giraffes
