Dear Parents/Carers,

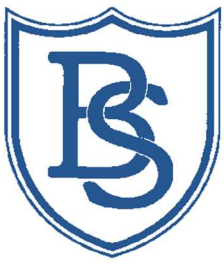
Medical Appointments
