Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to all Reception classes today, following their period of isolation. Thank you to all parents, carers and children themselves for the super work on Google Classroom. Please can we take this opportunity to remind parents/carers of the following Government guidance: If you or your child displays any covid-19 symptoms, you must book a PCR test and self-isolate until you

receive results. You must inform school of the illness and the subsequent test.

Government advice also recommends that twice weekly Lateral flow testing is available for all families. These tests are to detect asymptomatic cases and show results within 30 minutes. Tests are available:

- at a local test site
- by collecting a home test kit from a test site
- by ordering a home test kit online
