### Mental Health Awareness Week

This week is Mental Health Week. In school we have been discussing the power of positive thinking. We have used the notion of red thoughts/ unhelpful thoughts and green thoughts/ helpful thoughts. During class assembly time and circle time children have been practising to turn red thoughts into green thoughts e.g. Thomas in 1W changed "I can't do this" into "I am finding this tricky, so I am going to ask for help". Alex in 1W changed "I'm not very good at swimming" into "I can go to a swimming class and get better". Mrs Kenny has also recently attended a Mental Health First Aid course and is now our 'Mental Health First Aid Champion' making sure that she is looking after staff as well as children's mental health.
