

Dear Parents/Carers,

GMB Strike action on Tuesday 14th May

School is closed to all Nursery, Reception and Year 1 children. The only children that should attend school are those in Year 2 and all BIB registered classes.

The school office will be closed all day- any urgent correspondence on the day should be emailed to enquiry-inf@boldmere.bham.sch.uk. Phone calls and gate access will only be taken in emergencies. Breakfast club for children will not be available.

Lunches for Tuesday must be ordered by Parents- School cannot take responsibility for orders on the day.

Congratulations to our school council for organising such a super fundraising event last week! It was lovely to see everyone involved in baking biscuits and cakes at school, ready for the cake sale on Friday. The cafe was well attended and I do believe that everything baked by the children tasted delicious! Thank you to Mrs Mason for helping to organise the event and to all children for donating - we will let you know how much was raised next week. Once we have a total, school council will be looking through catalogues to choose the new bikes for ordering!

As part of our ongoing school monitoring, we have been working closely with other local schools this week, moderating our expected outcomes for the end of year teacher assessments across Early years and Key stage 1. We are pleased to know that our professional judgements align with other professionals, and our expectations remain some of the highest among our colleagues.

As you may be aware, Statutory testing for end of Year 2 children is optional from this year, and as a school, we have chosen to base our judgements on teacher knowledge rather than optional tests. It is reassuring to know that the cross school moderation meetings provide valuable opportunities to validate our judgements with other professionals. Parents/carers will be provided with assessment information in the end of year reports in July.

As a school we use the library as a resource to support our teaching and learning - at least 5 of our classes have visited this year as well as our year 2 librarians. The library also supports the school with our 'Book Explorers' by sourcing books for children to help them achieve the challenge.

As you may be aware Birmingham City Council has to make significant savings over the next few years and the proposal is to drastically reduce library provision. There is a 12 week public consultation underway which finishes on 17th July and everyone is encouraged to read the proposals and fill in the Be Heard questionnaire.
