#### **Jubilee Celebrations**

There have been a number of creative, fun activities running alongside the tests, planned to support everyone's mental health and wellbeing during these weeks. Outcomes from the teacher assessments will be shared with parents in the end of year reports. Data is also submitted to the Local Authority and the Department of Education. Thanks also go to the year 2 staff for the support, encouragement and guidance they have provided for their classes to ensure the SATs are delivered in an age-appropriate manner.

#### **Busy Bodies**

#### Infant school disco.

**Reception-** What a lovely day you are all going to have at Ash End farm and then a disco to finish off your amazing day.

Busy Bodies Reception children- if they are booked into Busies in the afternoon, we will collect them from the infants at the normal time and bring them down to Busies where they can get changed and have their snacks. We will then return to infants and hand over to the staff in charge of the disco. Staff will also give them a list of the children who they will return to collect at 5pm and escort back to Busies.

**Year 1 & Year 2-**We will collect as normal and take them down to Busies, at around 5pm we will take them back up to the infants for their lovely disco and hand over to the staff in charge. These children will need to be collected by parents/ carers at 6:15pm when the disco finishes.

Please feel free to send your child's disco clothes in a clearly labelled bag and we will keep them at Busy Bodies for the afternoon session, where they will then get changed for the disco.

Please inform the Busy Bodies Manager should you wish to collect your child from the disco and they are booked into Busies later than 5pm, this enables us to have the correct numbers of children to return to us after the disco finishes.

**ParentPay reminder**- Kindly ensure that your child's ParentPay account is up to date including your May fees payment- We will be sending out ParentPay reminders for those outstanding fees by the end of Tuesday. **Key work sessions**- On Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May we will be holding year group meetings with our children.
