Dear Parents / Carers,

Please see information from the infant school in regards to covid cases. Currently in the junior school, we have 5 confirmed positive cases. We are waiting on results from a further 6 children and staff.

# Covid Cases - Outbreak Management At Infant School

During the course of this weekend, we have had a huge increase in the number of positive cases at school. Currently we have 10 staff members and 20 children as confirmed positive cases. We are waiting on results from a further 15 children and staff. We have also had to close our Nursery provision until Wednesday 24th November. Our Outbreak Management plan is also in effect.

Please can we ask that parents monitor their children for any covid-19 symptoms, no matter how mild you may think they are. Continue with lateral flow testing and seek a PCR test immediately if your child displays symptoms. Mask wearing is also recommended around school.

Please note that all children must be in school if they have not tested positive. Parents have a statutory duty to ensure children are at school. We completely understand that some parents may want to keep their children at home but please be reassured that medical advice states that most positive cases in children are very mild.

We are encouraging hand washing, keeping areas well ventilated, and limiting mixing within school.

Remote learning for all children with positive PCRs will be provided. We are doing our best to get these children signed up today but please bear with us, limited staffing is having an impact on how quickly we can facilitate this. NO 10

# Reminder Regarding COVID-19.

If your child displays any COVID-19 symptoms, they must have a PCR test and isolate at home until the results are received.

If results are negative, your child may return to school if they are well enough to do so.

If results are positive, your child must isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or the test date.

If your child is taking a PCR test as they have been identified as a possible close contact, they can attend school as long as they have no COVID-19 symptoms.

Lateral flow testing should be used for asymptomatic testing. If your child has any COVID-19 symptoms, they must book a PCR test.

Please ensure you let the school office know, in advance, if you book a PCR test for your child and advise the office of the result of the test before your child returns to school.

**<u>REMINDER</u>**: If you are communicating with the school regarding your child's absence or regarding a PCR test result, please email through to 'enquiry@boldmere.bham.sch.uk' and <u>NOT</u> the year group email address. Thank you.

# Google Classroom

Google Classroom is the digital online platform for children that are selfisolating due to a positive Covid-19 test result.

When school receives notice from a parent/carer that the child has received a positive PCR test result, the child will be given access to the Google Classroom page. If the child is ill, there is no expectation for work to be completed, but if the child is well then work can be accessed, completed and sent in for the teacher to see. On the Google Classroom page, the child will find work that is in line with what is being taught in school.
