Reminder Regarding COVID-19.

If your child displays any COVID-19 symptoms, they must have a PCR test and isolate at home until the results are received.

If results are negative, your child may return to school if they are well enough to do so.

If results are positive, your child must isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or the test date.

If your child is taking a PCR test as they have been identified as a possible close contact, they can attend school as long as they have no COVID-19 symptoms.

Lateral flow testing should be used for asymptomatic testing. If your child has any COVID-19 symptoms, they must book a PCR test.

Please ensure you let the school office know, in advance, if you book a PCR test for your child and advise the office of the result of the test before your child returns to school.

In the Spring term, we are pleased to say we will be continuing with our swimming lessons, for children in Year 5. These will be occurring on a Wednesday morning. For lessons, children will require a swimming costume for girls or swimming trunks or shorts (these must not go below the knee) for boys.

Attendance and Lateness

We continue to track attendance and lateness at the end of each term. However, this term, due to the disruption caused by COVID, we recognise that many children have had unavoidable absences due to COVID and isolation after taking PCR tests. If we are concerned about your child's attendance, we will contact you.

Music Lessons – Autumn Term 2021 - fees

If you have not yet paid for the Autumn term, please check your ParentPay account and do so as soon as possible. All lessons must be paid for in advance.
