We are pleased to see 3K and 3H back in school this week. Unfortunately, we had to close 4M Bubble this week. They are working hard from home and we can't wait to have them back in school as soon as they can return.

A reminder that cases of the Delta Variant are rising across the local area and symptoms are presenting differently. Some children have sickness and diarrhoea/upset tummy and some have sore throats and headaches. Please continue to follow the government guidance:

If your child displays any Covid-19 symptoms you must book a PCR test and the whole family must self-isolate until you receive the results. You must inform the school of the illness in the first instance and then of the test results once received.

Government advice also recommends that twice weekly lateral flow tests are carried out by families. These tests are to detect asymptomatic cases and show results within 30 minutes.
