Covid-19

With restrictions easing, it is still vital that we remain incredibly vigilant to help manage and mitigate the risks that Covid-19 still presents. Over the past few weeks, many schools have seen the impact of the Delta variant, which has resulted in several 'class-bubble' closures, right across the country. Unfortunately, this has been the case at our school and we have experienced a significant number of 'class-bubble' closures recently, including two in the last three days. This impacts significantly upon children, staff and parents alike, as self-isolation is a requirement of positive contact.

Please keep up your wonderful efforts to help to manage the spread of the virus as we certainly do not want any further impact upon our school community. Thank you once again for your ongoing support and understanding, it is always very much appreciated. Let us hope we have no further 'class-bubble' closures before the end of the term.

Free School Meal Eligibility – Self Isolation

If your child is self isolating and is eligible for free school meals, please contact the school office by 9.30 am tomorrow morning to obtain further information.

Contact Tracing

In line with the recent government announcements, all under 18s will be exempt from isolation for contact with a positive case from 16th August 2021. From 19th July, schools will no longer contact trace as this will be completed via NHS test and trace. With restrictions lifting on the 19th July, school will be continuing with the year group bubbles until the end of the summer term.
