Tip 1: Week 5



Use reusable containers to minimise waste. Skip the plastic bags and clingfilm which is nigh-on indestructible and is turning our oceans and waterways into one big polluted mess. Put your child's food in reusable or recyclable containers. Or make your own reusable, washable beeswax wraps. Avoid individually wrapped items, snack packs, and single-serve containers. Buy larger containers of items as this type of shopping will save you lots of money and reduce waste. Packaging makes up 30% of the weight of an item and 50% of rubbish by volume.
