## School Meals, including Roast Wednesday and Pizza Friday

School meals are £2.35 per day, which equates to £11.75. If you wish to pay for the half term (up to February 2020), the amount will be £68.15 (29 days).

- Roast Wednesday meals for the whole of the term (up to Easter 2020) is 12 weeks = £28.20.
- Pizza Friday meals for the whole of the term (up to Easter 2020) is 12 weeks £28.20.
- For both Roast Wednesday and Pizza Friday meals, the total amount will be £56.40

May we take this opportunity to remind you that school meals must be paid for in advance of receiving the meal. Please ensure you check your ParentPay account weekly to be sure you are in credit should you wish your child to receive a school meal.

# **Parking Restriction Notice From Birmingham City Council**

A reminder that Notice is hereby given that Birmingham City Council have made an Order the effect of which will be no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on Cofield Road Sutton Coldfield, between property number 10 and property number 26. The temporary Order is required to allow installation of new drainage runs. Access to frontages will be maintained as necessary.

These prohibitions shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. The Order will come into operation on 13th January and will remain in force for a period of 2 weeks or until the works are completed whichever is the earlier.
