Flu Vaccinations - New Date

The school nurse will be in school on Wednesday 27th November to administer the nasal vaccination to Reception, Year One and Year Two children; parents are not required to attend.

General Election - School Closure - 12/12/2019

It is important that parents/carers understand the decision to use the school as a polling station is outside of our control. We know many parents and carers will be frustrated about the closure and the disruption it brings. Believe me when I say the teaching staff share this frustration, particularly as it comes during such a busy point in the term. The governing board is concerned about the school continuing to be used in this way and has started a discussion with the election office about finding an alternative venue for future elections. The unusually short notice of this latest general election means change is not possible in time for the authority to meet its legal obligations. However, with further elections scheduled for May 2020, the election office has committed to reviewing the use of Boldmere Schools as a polling station in the new year. We will therefore be pursuing this then and will provide an update once we have one. In the meantime the schools will be closed to all pupils on Thursday 12 December 2019.

Anti-Bullying Week 11th-15th November

We will be using the week to explore friendships, how to be a good friend and how to be kind (linked to our value Kindness).
