Covid-19 Update

As many parents/carers are aware, we have been impacted greatly by Covid-19 during the last two weeks. Staff and pupil absences have reached very high numbers. We currently have **9 staff and 53 children** that are isolating as a result of testing positive for covid-19. As of today, Year 1 have 33 cases, and numbers are creeping up in other year groups.

Transmission between our young children seems to be taking place at quite a rate, despite our covid prevention strategies however, we are in daily contact with Public Health to ensure we are taking every precaution available to prevent the spread.

- Year 1 classes received a deep clean yesterday and all toys, books, pencils scissors, drawers, coat pegs etc. have been disinfected by staff.
- All lunchtime clubs are taking place outside, violin lessons have been postponed, and whole school assemblies have been cancelled.
- Staff are continuing to take lateral flow tests and visitors are required to wear masks around school.

Thank you to all year 1 parents for ensuring that PCR testing was undertaken prior to children returning to school today. Please continue to take daily lateral flow tests for the next 7 days, as advised in our parentmail on 20.11.21.

Please can we ask parents/carers across school to continue to monitor their children for covid-19 symptoms and book a PCR immediately. Please speak to the school office if you require further guidance or advice.
