Severe weather arrangements

The decision to close a school due to severe weather lies with the Executive Headteacher (Mr. Glasgow) and Head of School (Mrs. Kenny), in consultation with the Chair of the Governing Board. This arrangement enables decisions to be taken quickly, in the light of local circumstances and or factors unique to the school, such as local transport or site related issues. On taking the decision to close the School due to severe weather, Mr. Glasgow/Mrs. Kenny will inform BCC. An immediately update for parents/carers will be made on the school's website with notification of the closure as well as using parentmail messaging and social media to keep parents informed.

In extreme circumstances such as very heavy snowfall, the Director, Children and Families, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Families, may decide to close all schools and centres that are maintained by BCC. The timing of the decision will be informed by an assessment of the conditions and forecast. It will also seek to prevent people making unnecessary journeys. Headteachers will be notified of the decision via their school email. It will also be announced on the BCC website and through social media channels.

Expectations when using toilets at school.

We are pleased to say that most children at Boldmere show respect and behave appropriately throughout the day, including when they use the toilets at school. However, it has become clear this term that some children are not using the toilets properly, despite many reminders from staff regarding our expectations. We would like to work with parents and ask that you take some time at home, to discuss and reiterate our expectations at school. Staff are spending precious teaching time throughout the day, monitoring behaviour in the toilets and it is important that the children help to keep these areas clean and tidy. Our expectations are as follows: *Use the toilet, put down the lid, flush the toilet and then wash and dry your hands properly with paper towels.

*Use the bins for the paper towels, do not put them in the toilet.

*Nothing should be placed into the toilet except toilet paper.

*The toilet is not a playground or area to socialise so use the toilet sensibly then return to your class quickly and quietly.
