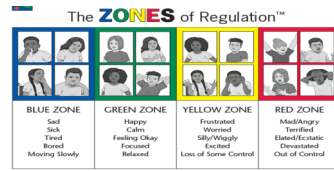


Communication and Language

Uses vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by their experiences of books – multi-sensory adult led activity to learn the unknown vocabulary from the story.

Listen to stories. accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions – learning to act out a retell with actions following the shared creation of a story map, then telling the story in their own words to be scribed. To use more complex sentences to link thoughts – using the Colourful Semantics system to create full oral sentences to outline 'who', 'doing what' and 'where'.

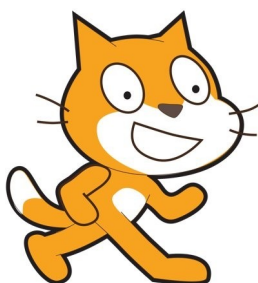

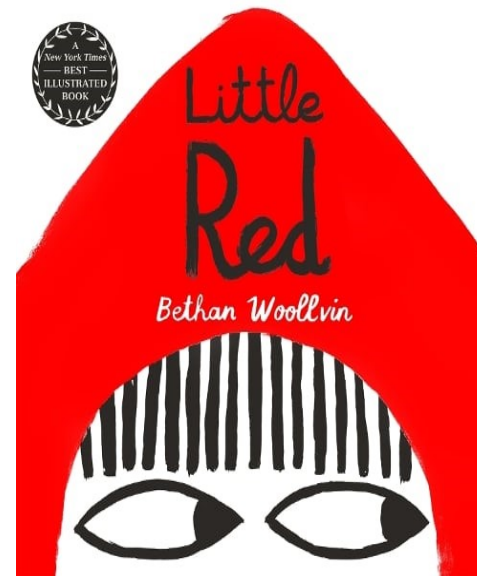
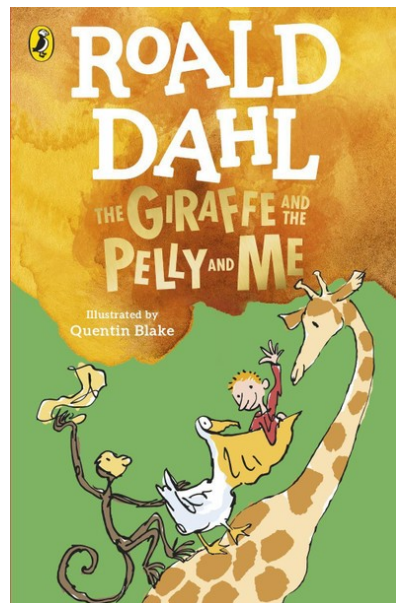
