
Parent Feedback Survey – Autumn 2025 Summary

Thank you to all parents who took the time to complete our recent feedback survey. We received **83 responses**, and your views are invaluable in helping us continue to improve.

Key Highlights:

- **Happiness and Safety:** Over **95% of parents agreed or strongly agreed** that their child is happy and feels safe at school.
- **Behaviour and Standards:** The majority of parents feel the school ensures good behaviour and takes action when needed.
- **Learning and Progress:** Most parents are confident their child is doing well and appreciate the updates on what their child is learning.
- **Communication:** While many parents praised newsletters and parent evenings, some suggested more frequent updates and opportunities to celebrate achievements in school.
- **SEND Support:** Parents of children with additional needs expressed gratitude for the support provided, though a few noted areas for improvement in communication.
- **Clubs and Enrichment:** Parents value the range of clubs and enrichment activities, with some requesting more variety and availability.
- **Overall Recommendation:** Nearly all respondents said they would recommend the school to other parents.
