Previous lunchtime play leader experience is not necessary, just a commitment to the safety and welfare of all our children and a willingness to be involved in our successful Boldmere team.

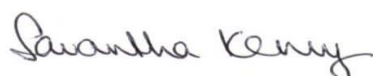
