Start and End Of The School Day Changes

Thank you to all parents/carers who are supporting us to reduce gatherings on and around the school site. We are now able to reduce the staggered start and end times to the school day as children are familiar with these routines.

We hope that the new times will help parents/carers with siblings at both schools. The new times will be from Monday 21st September.

Please ensure that only ONE adult comes onto the school site during drop off and collection times.

The new times are:

Reception- 9am start time and 3.10pm collection time. 12pm collection on a Friday.

Year One- 8.55am start time and 3.15pm collection time. 12.05pm collection on a Friday.

Year Two- 8.50am start time and 3.20 collection time. 12.10pm collection on a Friday.

Home and School Agreement

Your child will be bringing home a 'Home and School Agreement' booklet this week. Inside it will contain the class rules that your children have written with their teacher and also includes a brief outline of the strategy. In addition we have provided an agreement specifically related to the current Covid 19 situation. Please read with your children, then both parent and child need to sign the agreements and send back into school as soon as possible. Thank you for your continued support.

Lunches And Snacks

Fruit snacks are now being provided each day, as part of the Government's fruit scheme. All children will receive a piece of fruit/snack each day so will not need to be provided with anything from home.

If you have ordered a school packed lunch for your child please DO NOT send in a lunchbox from home to supplement the food provided by school. Extra food from home is not required.

If you have ordered a school lunch and have decided you no longer wish your child to receive a school packed lunch then please let the office know as soon as possible.

Please send a NAMED water bottle to school each day. This must only contain WATER. Squash leaves sticky messes if it is knocked over, and encourages creepy crawlies such as ants! The bottles can be topped up during the day as necessary.

COVID 19 Guidance-

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- A high temperature- above 38.
- A new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour / three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this will probably not be applicable for Infant children but may affect older siblings or parents. If you have any of these symptoms you must get a test to check if you have coronavirus and stay at home until you get your result. Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get your result. If you need medical advice, contact NHS 111. Children should not be coming into school if they have any of these symptoms.

You need to inform school immediately with any results of tests when you receive them. School will require a copy of any test results.
