A few reminders this week but hopefully a shorter newsletter than last week!

Firstly we would like to say a huge congratulations to all our fabulous children this week!

Reception are all now attending full time and enjoyed their first lunchtime menu yesterday.

Nursery have all begun their part-time/full-time sessions and Mr Meakin and Mrs Hakim are very pleased with how well everyone is settling. Year 1 and Year 2 children are transitioning into their new routines and although some have found these changes a little tricky, they have shown resilience and perseverance when faced with new challenges. We are very proud at how they are supporting our younger Reception children too.










Our Makaton Signs for Autumn are:
