Urgent Letter From The Health Practitioner, UK Health Security Agency-West Midlands

We have been informed that a small number of children who attend school have been diagnosed with suspected scarlet fever. Following a conversation with the UK Health Security Agency yesterday, and in light of chicken pox also circulating in school, we have been advised to send the attached information as a matter of urgency to all parents. Please read the letter carefully and be vigilant of possible symptoms as detailed in the letter.

Water In School

Please can we ask that children bring water only in their water bottles. Children have access to their water bottles at all times during the school day and they are encouraged to drink at regular intervals. Water has huge health benefits and is extremely important in ensuring that children remain hydrated to perform at their best. Occasionally, children spill their drink and cleaning up drinks other than water can become very messy. Dentists also advise that children should only drink either water or milk between meals. We thank you for your co-operation in this.

 \cdot Parents evening- Our first one of the year will be held on October 19th. Further details will follow.


Celebrations
