

Spring 2026 Parent Feedback – Summary

Thank you to all parents and carers who took the time to complete our recent Spring Feedback Survey. We received 71 responses, and your views are invaluable in helping us continue to improve our school community. Here are the key themes that emerged:

What parents told us we are doing well

- **Children are happy and feel safe**
The overwhelming majority of parents *strongly agree* that their child is happy at school and feels safe.
- **High-quality teaching and care**
Many comments praised teachers and support staff for their dedication, warmth, and strong knowledge of each child's needs.
- **Behaviour and wellbeing support**
Parents widely agree that the school promotes good behaviour and supports pupils' wellbeing effectively.
- **Positive experiences at parents' evening**
Several parents highlighted that recent parents' evenings were informative, well delivered, and helpful in understanding their child's progress.
- **SEND support**
Families of children with SEND shared very positive feedback about the proactive and caring support provided by staff and the SEND team.
- **Strong relationships and communication with teachers**
Many parents commented on how approachable and supportive staff are, and how this contributes to their child's positive experience at school.

Areas where parents would like further improvement

- **Communication**
A number of parents requested more regular updates between parents' evenings, including quicker acknowledgement of emails.
- **Clubs and enrichment activities**
Some parents felt that the range and availability of lunchtime or after-school clubs could be expanded.
- **Parents' evening format**
A few parents expressed a preference for face-to-face appointments rather than phone calls, and some found the 10-minute slots too short.
- **Curriculum information**
A small number of parents asked for more frequent updates about what their child is learning so they can support learning at home.
- **Timely sharing of concerns**
A few comments highlighted the importance of raising any issues—particularly around learning needs—earlier in the year.
- **School hygiene rating communication**
One concern was raised regarding communication about the school's hygiene rating and how information was shared.

Here are a few of the many lovely comments shared:

- *“Lovely school!”*
- *“The staff are always very warm and welcoming.”*
- *“Amazing school and staff.”*
- *“My children have had lovely experiences at Boldmere... the kind, dedicated and talented staff make such a difference.”*
- *“We really appreciate all of the support our son receives at school. It’s great to hear he’s made progress.”*
- *“Amazing school, amazing staff... very supportive... very happy to be part of the Boldmere school family.”*
- *“All the staff we have come into contact with seem to genuinely care about our daughter’s wellbeing.”*
- *“A huge thank you... I feel assured that everything is being done to help my child thrive.”*
